Bigmama was a very particular housekeeper and kept herself immaculently clean as well. Bigmama was married a second time in Texas but it did not last very long. Notes written by Joanne Goodman Denos her granddaughter" Martha raised her children by herself on their small farm. She took in sewing to help pay expenses, Her father helped her raise her children and he was very strict with the boys. Martha was always meticulous in her own home and also about her own self. In her later years she always had her hair done each week and wore make up and well coordinated clothes always spotlessly clean. She wore cotton dress for her house work and then took a shower or bath shortly before noon and

dressed in a nice dress, applied her make up and combed her hair and was ready for sewing or for visiting or shopping. She was a good cook and always cleaned up her mess as she cooked never leaving lots of dirty pots and pans to clean at the end of a meal. The pan was always soaking in the sink while we ate so after dinner the dishes were easy. She always had African violets in her corner window above her sink. She loved to work in the yard and we kidded her about having a green thumb. She liked people and looked forward to going to her sewing circle once a week at the Baptist Church. While working around the house her two favorite songs to sing were The Old Rugged Cross and I come to the Garden Alone. She loved to sing and had a beautiful contralto voice. She enjoyed telling us of her dating days. She talked about her beaux and how a nice girl never kissed a boy until the day she was married. She loved to tell about driving in a horse and buggy with her beaux. She would compare her dates to ours and we would really enjoy listening to her tell of picnics and taffy pulls and making popcorn. We called her Bigmama. We loved her dearly. She had a sense of humor and a love to serve others. She was always talking about her weight and careful not to eat too much but she always ate a big breakfast and she loved a bite of candy. She'd always say " I shouldn't eat this but its so good". We always laughed and enjoyed the treat and never told anyone about it." Have found some records where her name is given as Martha June.

By this union three children were born to him, one of whom, Mrs.Thomas Pierce is still living. In January 1834 Mr. Pevehouse emigrated to this state settling in Brazoria County, in in 1835 enlisted in the war against Mexico which he served until hostilities ceased and texas declared her independence. In 1837 he moved with his family to Fort Bend county where he coninued to reside until the death of his wife June 6th 1841, when he moved to Montgomery county where October 16th 1842 he met and married Miss Malinda Pierce, who still lives to mourn his death. By this union were born 14 children who came to bless his housefold while here on earth. In 1851 Mr. Pevehouse moved to Navarro County and located here in Frost and in 1852 joined the Baptist church and was ordained a Deacon and was honored as a delegate to the Baptist Association 26 times. From the 14 children this aged Patriarch claimed

51 grand children living and several dead, 36 great grandchildren and 4 great great grandchildren. This grand old man had been a citizen of our county for 45 years during all that time had given liberally to every enterprise and to the schools and churches especially and the fact that he had lived in the State 63 years justly entitled him to the application of an "old Texan". We well remember when we used to wagon with this Texan going to Houston then our nearest market for supplies. The steam engine has long since superceded the slow going ox team that at the time required three or four weeks to make the round trip which is now made by rail in 24 hours, yet these old Texans gave us this fair land of ours teeming with its millions of human beings its happy homes, its costly churches and splendid schools and we have reason to reverence their memory long after they have been called away. caused the [unreadable] seal of the said Commonwealth to be Affixed at Richmond on the Twenty sixth day of October, In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six of the Commonwealth the Twentyfirst [signed] Robert Brooke" On May 23, 1797, George Holland sold 23 acres of land on Beaver Dam fork of Elk Creek, Grayson County, Virginia to Peter Snider (Published Source: Grayson County Deed Book 1, page 78; Research Source: Sandra Lake Lassen). On July 27, 1797, George Holland sold 220 acres of land on Beaver Dam Creek, Grayson County, Virginia to Peter Delp h (Published Source: Grayson County Deed Book 1, page 105 ; Research Source: Sandra Lake Lassen). On September 12, 1797, George Holland was granted 164 acres on Chesnut Creek in Montgomery County, Virginia. (Published Source: Grants 35, page 553; Research Source: Timothy J. Barron). [signed] James Wood" George died in late June or early July 1802 in Grayson County, Virginia. His will was dated June 22, 1802, proved in July 1802, and inventoried in August 1802 (Published Source : Grayson County Virginia Will Book I, pages 16-17; Research Source: Sandra Lake Lassen). Also I give unto my beloved wife Mary Holland all my household furniture forever except my bed which I leave unto my Daughter Agathy Brewer or Russe l Also I leave unto my wife Mary Holland my book accounts against M. Jones for plank 500 feet of [two words obscured] half bushels of Grain the which is full amount. Also 100 0 feet plank to be paid by Joseph Jackson and after my decease. I direct my Debts to be collected from all those indebted and all Just Debts to be paid from said monies and twenty Pounds of said money if it be collected I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Basham and case it cannot be collected she is still to receive the sum from monies that shall afterwards be collected. I also direct my negroe Woman Jin, my Bu l l run Tract of Land to be sold and twelve months Credit to be given and the money to be equally divided amongst all my Legatees hereafter named. Also the Tract of land whereon I now live to be sold in same manner as my other land and the money to be divided in the same manner as my other Missouri nies. This last Tract of land to be sold after the decease of my Wife or her marriage together. All monies that shall be found after the payment of all my Just Debts and the Twenty pounds to Elizabeth Basham to be equally divided amongst William Holland, Agathy Brewer or Russell, Fanny Hatfield, Sarah Cope, Judah Vaughn and Elizabeth Basham. And lastly I do appoint Mary Holland, William Hall & John Hall my Executors to this my last Will and testament. Witness my hand & seal this 22nd day of June 1802. In presence of Minette

The following article, "George and Mary Holland" written by Sandra Lake Lassen, appeared in the book "Bicentennial Heritage Grayson County, Virginia," dated 1995, on page 245: "More than one George Holland lived and died in Virginia's early days, and the parentage of Grayson County's George Holland, my 6th great-grandfather, has been debated by many of his descendants. However, it is certain that he appears as early as 1782 in the portion of Montgomery County that became Grayson, where he is taxed as owning 3 horses and 11 cattle. His land is described as '400 acres, both sides of Beaver Creek Dam, fork of Elk Creek.' In 1793-1794, George was appointed surveyor of roads in newly formed Grayson County. From 1797 to 1802, he appears several times in Grayson County land records, both buying and selling land in the Elk Creek, Chesnut Creek and Bull Run areas. George died in late June or early July 1802. His will and inventory are both on file at the Grayson County Courthouse. He names his wife Mary and their children William Holland, Agatha (Mrs. Lewis Brewer), Fanny (Mrs. Jeremiah Hatfield), Sarah (Mrs. Cope), Judah (Mrs. Vaughn), and Elizabeth (Mrs. Basam). George's wife Mary's maiden name is unknown. In his will, he left her his plantation and household furniture, with the exception of his bed (a very valuable item on the early frontier) which he left to his daughter, 'Agath y.' The 1802 inventory of George's estate shows a family quite affluent for those hard times, when one considers that everything they brought with them to Grayson County had to be carried over the mountains. Items include pewter, tin cups, crockery cups and saucers, a coffee pott, a flat iron, knives and forks, 3 beds, 15 hogs, 1 cow, 2 calves, 1 yearling, and a horse, as well as numerous farm implements. Soon after George's death, his son, William, and his grandson, John, left the Grayson County area. Descendants of George and Mary Holland, through their grandson John Holland, number in the thousands and hold an annual reunion each year in various locations in Arkansas, Oklahoma, or Kentucky, depending on who is hosting that particular year. He may have traveled along the Pennsylvania Wagon Road across Maryland into Virginia. He owned land in Lunenburg County, Virginia between 1741 and 1745. In 1746 he patented land near present day Martinsville, Virginia at a site known as "Round About" because of a bend in the Smith River. Elisha Walling was appointed constable in 1748 of a territory later to become Henry and Patrick Counties in Virginia. He took the oath of allegiance in 1777 in Henry County, Virginia. Elisha is listed on the Henry County Personal Property Tax Lists for 1778, 1779, and 1780. On February 27, 1783 Elisha Walling and William Roberts were credited with furnishing supplies to the Continental Army of the American Revolution. Elisha furnished two pecks of cornmeal and 20 pounds of bacon to Colonel Lee's Legion. He also contributed one beef to Captain Robinson's Company of Volunteers on their way Southward. Elisha Walling may have been killed by Indians while hunting. One account states: "On the hunters' return to camp the other men saw blood on the snow and found the remains of him and his companion; some say that Wallin's dog led them to his body while others say that his dog stood over the bodies protecting them from wild beasts. At any rate, these men had been killed by Indians and it is the first known death of a white scout to be scalped in Harland County, Kentucky. The ridge where they camped, the creek, and the town of "Wallins" were named for him. His body was found whence almost decayed recognized by the buttons on his clothes". This version of Elisha Walling's death has some credence, since no will has ever been found. This would indicate his death was unexpected, for normally when ill, a person would have written a will.

He was 80 years old when he died in western NC, now Tennessee. He and son Joshua were on French Broad River in 1784 and in Western Country on a petition for a new county/state? in 1787. The French Broad River runs from somewhere below and through the present city of Asheville up 210 miles into Tennessee, joining the Holston River to form Tennessee River near Knoxville. The critical point is, just where on the French Broad River were they? The births of two of his children, Zipporah and Christopher are recorded in the St. Paul's Church Register in Baltimore. The names of the other children have been found on various records associated with their father and with each other in various ways. As these families moved westward, some of the family traditions and records were passed on to the present day generations. Though the records are incomplete they represent a beginning and can be added to.

In 1731 Nathaniel received a gift of 284 acres from his father. In 1745 Nathaniel and brother Christopher sold several tracts of land and soon after moved to southern Va.
